

GUNNEDAH CULTURAL PRECINCT



The Cultural Precinct offers a variety of well-appointed purpose built function rooms for community use. It is the perfect venue for conferences, with tiered style seating and caters for small or large, private or corporate functions – wedding receptions, parties, product launches or meetings. A range of spaces are available within The Cultural Precinct.

The Civic Theatre is your ideal location for theatre productions, plenary conference sessions or award presentations. It has multiple break out spaces, the Mooki Room, Gallery, Studio Room and Meeting Room. Each taking capacity of 15-20 people.

The Town Hall can host formal dinners of up to 250 people or a large theatre performance for 500. The Smithurst being a more intimate space great for all day workshops, training and rehearsals.

2023/2024 VENUE HIRE

Organisations eligible for discounted community hire rates per councils Schedule of Fees & Charges are defined as follows:

- The organisation must be local to the Gunnedah Shire; it may also be a local chapter of a larger national or international organisation, and;
- Must be a not-for-profit community group or registered charity undertaking an activity that provides genuine community benefit or be a genuine charitable endeavour, or;
- Council has determined by resolution to classify the group as being eligible for the discounted community rate on a one-off or ongoing basis.
- All other hirers are, by default, classified as Commercial and subject to the full commercial hire fee.



Spaces can be accessed from 81 Chandos Street via the Civic main entrance doors.








BICENTENNIAL CREATIVE ARTS CENTRE

There is no better way to be immersed in the local culture of Gunnedah than by holding your next meeting or event in our creative arts gallery.














THE CIVIC THEATRE

The Civic Theatre was built in 2001 and is situated in the heart of Gunnedah. Patrons to the theatre are able to enjoy The Civics' programming of new releases, art-house and archival films in an intimate atmosphere and luxurious seating. The Civic boasts high-tech digital projection, surround sound and very comfortable seating for up to 134 people.

The Theatre comprises a stage for touring and local theatrical productions and with its superb acoustics it is a popular venue for live music. Informal functions are well suited to the light contemporary space of The Civics' foyer and adjacent Mooki room. Additional rooms are also available within the complex to compliment cinema and theatre functions.








SMITHURST THEATRE

The Gunnedah Smithurst Theatre was built in the 1930's and was home to Gunnedah's Dramatic Society. It was once called The Gunnedah Small Town Hall but was renamed after the Dramatic Society President Dr. Smithurst. The Smithurst is frequently used for conferences, community events, disco's, rehearsals and meetings as well as intimate theatre performances. The Smithurst features a stage, dance floor, air conditioning and heating as well as 3 phase power at the back of the stage. The Smithurst Theatre also has a commercial kitchen and 2 x dressing rooms.

Main entrance to the Smithurst Theatre is 144 Conadilly Street.









TOWN HALL

Built in the 1920's, the Town Hall is the historic heart of Gunnedah's Cultural Precinct. The Town Hall stands proudly as a testament to Gunnedah's architectural and civic heritage; with its period features and classic charm resonating with locals and visitors alike. Featuring a vast dance floor, air conditioning and heating, the Town Hall is an ideal venue for hosting special events, conferences, concerts, balls, wedding receptions and other large indoor events.

Entrance to the Town Hall is via 144 Conadilly Street.
